Petitioner seeks parole for seven weeks under Section 3(1) (A) of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoner (Temporary Release) Act, 1988 on medical grounds.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that earlier the petitioner has filed an application dated 25.8.2018, before Superintendent, District Jail, Karnal (Annexure P-2) on the ground that he has suffered heart attack. He further submits that in fact the said application was not accepted by the Superintendent, District Jail, Karnal who is duty bound to accept the application and pass the order on the same.

It being so, present petition is disposed of with a direction to Superintendent, District Jail, Karnal to accept the application of the petitioner for parole on medical grounds accompanied by the documents and decide the same within five days as per the instructions of the Government of Haryana.

Disposed of accordingly.
