The present writ petition has been filed by the petitioner claiming retiral benefits.

It has been averred in the petition that the petitioner retired as Inspector from Municipal Corporation, Pathankot on 30.06.2018.

No details of the amount has been given in the writ petition for which the petitioner is entitled for and is being withheld by the respondents without any valid justification.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has drawn my attention to representation dated 06.08.2018 (Annexure P-2) sent to respondent No. 4 and submits that the petitioner will be satisfied if a time bound direction is given to the respondents to decide his representation dated 06.08.2018 (Annexure P-2) for release of the retiral benefits along with interest.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the present writ petition with a direction to

respondent No. 4 to pass appropriate orders in accordance with law on the representation dated 06.08.2018 (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioner within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case the petitioner is found entitled for any amount, the same should also be released to him within a next period of three months.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
