Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ particularly in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to grant revised pensionary benefits after counting her service from June 1963 to July 22, 1973 in Guru Nanak Girls Sr. Sec. School, District Amritsar against regular sanctioned Aided post before joining Government School, as qualifying service for the purpose of pension in view of the judgment of this Court in CWP No.14238 of 1991 captioned as *Sukhdev Singh & ors. vs. State of Punjab & ors.* decided on 10.03.2010 (P-1).

2. At the very outset of the arguments, it has emerged that respondents have already passed the order No.12/13-18 Voc(6) dated 20.03.2018 (R-1), during the pendency of instant petition, whereby relief claimed by the petitioner through instant petition stands granted and further

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a direction is issued to make the payment of the arrears to the petitioner within a period of four months positively.

3. In view of aforesaid order dated 20.03.2018 (R-1), instant petition has rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such. However, respondents are directed to comply with the aforesaid order dated 20.03.2018 (R-1) in its letter and spirit within the period already prescribed by the concerned authorities.
