C.M. No.17278 of 2018

Prayer in this application is for impleading the legal representatives of deceased Vidya Sagar (respondent No.5), who is stated to have died during the pendency of the writ petition, leaving behind the legal heirs as detailed in Para 1 of the application. Prayer has been made for impleading them as respondent Nos.5(i) to (iii). The said application is supported by an affidavit of Jatin Sagar son of late Vidya Sagar, resident of Village Farida Nagar, Tehsil and District Pathankot. It has been mentioned in Para 2 of the application that apart from the persons referred to above,

there is no other legal heir of deceased Vidya Sagar.

Counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the prayer made in the application.

In view of the above, the present application is allowed subject to all just exceptions.

The persons detailed in Para 1 of the application are impleaded as respondent Nos.5(i) to (iii). The amended memo of parties appended alongwith the application is taken on record. Registry is directed to place the same at an appropriate place of the case.

Mr.Munish Puri, Advocate, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of legal heirs of respondent No.5 and admits the factum of compromise dated 04.10.2018 (Annexure P-11) entered into between the petitioner and legal heirs of respondent No.5. State counsel also stats that it is a matter of Khasra Girdawari between the co-sharers and, therefore, he has no objection to the prayer made in the application.

In view of the above, C.M. No.19299 of 2018 is allowed.

The writ petition is permitted to be withdrawn in the light of the compromise dated 04.10.2018 (Annexure P-11) entered into between the parties. The parties would be bound by the terms and conditions of the said compromise.
