1. The prayer made in the writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for quashing the order dated 8.11.2017, Annexure P.6, issued under Section 13(4) of the Securitisation and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 (in short, `the Act') for e-auction of the secured assets. A prayer is also made to consider the proposal of the petitioner under prevalent under OTS scheme.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions from the petitioner, submitted that one account has

been closed, whereas, two others have been regularised and, therefore, the writ petition has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of as such.
