By virtue of the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought an issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to take the final decision on the legal notice dated 17.07.2017 and its addendum dated 10.06.2018 (P-2 & P-7).

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents particularly respondent No.2 to decide the aforesaid legal notices, in a time bound manner.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents particularly respondent No.2 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notices dated 17.07.2017 and 10.06.2018 (P-2 & P-7)

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and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order considering all the facts narrated in the aforesaid legal notices, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to the other remedies available under law as well as to approach this Court.
