This petition has been filed for issuance of direction to the respondents to revise the wages of the petitioners at DC rates, which are being revised from time to time.

In **Ram Harsh and others vs. The State of Haryana and others,** CWP No.1133 of 2010, decided on 19.05.2011 (Annexure P-7), petitioners, who were working as Cook/Water Carrier/Mali and Sweepers in Haryana Police as Contingent Part Time Employees, were earlier getting salary of Rs.2840/- per month. In response to the petitioner, the respondents did not place on record any material to show that those employees were actually working only for two hours in a day. The said petition was allowed and the petitioners (therein) were given salary at the rate of Rs.5400/- per month as per minimum wages in the year 2011-2012. The aforesaid judgment was, thereafter, followed in **Rakesh Kumar and others vs. The State of Haryana and others,** CWP No.12745 of 2015, decided on 29.01.2016 (Annexure P-

**8),** whereby directions were given to the respondents to give them the

minimum wages in consonance with the prescribed orders dated 06.06.2013 and 04.07.2014 (Annexures P-2 & P-3 therein).

In the present case, learned counsel for the respondents has not been able to show, whether the aforesaid judgments have been set aside by way of filing LPA. The petitioners have placed on record orders dated 06.06.2013, 04.07.2014, 14.05.2015 & 05.06.2017 (Annexures P-2, P-3, P-4 & P-6), whereby DC rates have been revised. The respondents are not disputing those orders.

Hence, keeping in view of the judgments passed in **Ram Harsh** and **Rakesh Kumar's** cases (supra) (Annexures P-7 & P-8), this petition is allowed and respondents are directed to give revised wages to all the petitioners as per orders dated 06.06.2013, 04.07.2014, 14.05.2015 & 05.06.2017 (Annexures P-2, P-3, P-4 & P-6) along with interest at the rate of 6% per annum, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
