The petitioner competed for selection to the post of Assistant Professor in Chemistry under the BC-A category.

Pursuant to the interim directions issued by this Court on December 06, 2017, she was directed to be provisionally interviewed, if the marks obtained by her in the written examination was more than the last candidate called for interview in her category.

For, score of the petitioner was more than the last candidate who was called for interview, the petitioner too was interviewed in terms of the order of this Court.

Learned counsel for the respondent has produced the result of the petitioner which shows that her total score, including the marks obtained in the interview, is 59.66% whereas, the last candidate who has been selected in her category has obtained 69.01 marks (cut off). Thus, he submits that the petitioner has failed to qualify for selection.

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that nothing substantive survives in this petition and the same be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

Ordered accordingly.
