Through the instant civil writ petition, the petitioners seek setting aside of letter dated 05.09.2012 (Annexure P-7) vide which the Department of Finance has rejected the claim of the petitioners for revision of pay scale.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners states that he will be satisfied in case the respondents are directed to send the case of the petitioners to Sixth Pay Commission for removal of the anomaly in the pay scales as recommended by the Director & Warden, Fisheries, Department of Punjab vide communication dated 11.05.2012 (Annexure P-6).

Learned counsel for the respondents states that he has no objection in case the submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioners is accepted.

In view of the above, it is ordered that the Sixth Pay Commission will consider the case of the petitioners and take appropriate decision thereupon. On completion of the exercise by the Sixth Pay Commission, if the grievance of the petitioners still survives, the petitioners shall be at liberty either to revive the present petition or to file afresh on the same cause of action.
