Petitioner is seeking quashing of the office order dated 01.09.2015 (Annexure P-1) and further issuance of direction to the respondent to consider his case of regularization on his service in terms of Govt. Policy in the year 1993, 1996, 2003 and 2014.

A perusal of the impugned order shows that petitioner has worked for 257 days in the year 1993, 171 days in 1994, 205 days in 1995, 29 days in 1996 and 47 days in 1997 as a daily wages. In this way except the year 1993, neither he completed 240 days in one year nor he has completed continuous service of five years. Therefore, the services of the petitioners cannot be regularized by the department.

In a specific reply to this aspect, the respondents have stated in paragraph 4 has clarified that petitioner wants to take undue advantage of identical name of another regular worker namely Dharma S/o Sh.Surja Ram of village Nadiali Tehsil and District Ambala by impersonating his identity.

Petitioner is also impersonating his identity and making the false claim by attaching attendance sheet of beldars working under Executive Engineer Provincial Division No.1, Ambala Cantt from 02/2006 to 01.10.2008 (Annexure P-3 page 34 to 64). The name shown in the attendance sheet relates to regular beldar namely Dharma son of Surja and not the petitioner. He has impersonated his name by procuring and forging the relevant record of attendance sheet just to claim benefit of regularization of his service.

Hence, the petitioner cannot get any benefit for regularization. As such, the present writ petition is dismissed as such.
