Petitioner is seeking a directions to the respondents to allow the petitioners continue till regular appointments are made, in case the petitioners are replaced and relieved from services by the respondents due to transferred/deputation regular or contractual lecturers from other colleges the respondent be directed to adjust the petitioners against available workload in the same college or the colleges from where the transferred has been made.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioners are working as Extension Lecturers as per experience certificate issued to them (Annexure P-1 colly.). They are still working but they have apprehension that they will be relieved from services due to deputation/transfer of other lectures and due to appointment/reinstatement of other contractual employees/lecturers. He has referred to the judgment in the identical case of **Pawan Kumar and others Vs. State of Haryana and others passed in CWP No.24163 of 2018** whereby, it was directed to the respondents to allow the petitioners to work till regular appointments are made and petitioners shall not be replaced on the basis of transfer of regular employees.

Notice of motion.

Mr.Kiran Pal Singh, AAG, Haryana, has appeared and accepts notice on behalf of respondent/State.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to allow the petitioners to work till regular appoints are made and the petitioners shall not be replaced on the basis of transfer of regular employee. However, It is further made clear that if some new regular candidate joins, the petitioners can be relieved, as per **Menka and others v. State of Haryana and others, decided on 05.05.2016** and further the respondents will consider the retention of the petitioner as per the guidelines issued on 13.07.2018 (Annexure P-4). This exercise shall be completed within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
