Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought an issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to decide the representation dated 25.08.2018 (P-3) in view of the judgment passed by this Court in CWP No.7862 of 2006 captioned as *Hanumant Singh & ors. vs. State of Haryana & ors.* decided on 04.07.2008 (P-1) by counting his period of ad hoc service for the purpose of seniority and for grant of all other relief(s).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though a representation was made to the respondent No.2 on 25.08.2018 (P-3) but till date no conscious decision has been taken thereon. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the above said representation (P-3), within some specified period.

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3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.2 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the representation dated 25.08.2018 (P-3) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order in view of judgment referred to above in para no.1 of this order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to the other remedies available under law as well as to approach this Court.
