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TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

Petitioner-Samiti, which is running a College, has filed the instant petition being aggrieved of the order dated 13.9.2018, Annexure P10, issued by the National Council for Teacher Education and in terms of which, recognition has been granted to the petitioner-College for the academic session 2019-2020 for running a diploma in Elementary Education Course with an intake of 100 students. It is the case of the petitioner-Institute that such recognition ought to have been granted for the academic session 2018-2019 instead.

During the course of arguments, it has gone uncontroverted that the counselling process for admission to the

diploma in Elementary Education Course for the session 2018-2019 has already come to an end.

Furthermore, the recognition that has been granted to the petitioner is for the session 2019-2020.

In view of such peculiar factual position, no ground for interference is made out.

Writ petition is disposed of.
