Petitioners have approached this Court praying for a writ of mandamus seeking directions to respondent No. 2 to consider the representation of the petitioners wherein certain irregularities, illegalities, embezzlement and another aspects have been pointed out and projected in The Chak Singha Multipurpose Cooperative Agricultural Service Society Ltd., Village Chak Singha, Tehsil Garhshankar, District Hoshiarpur. Quo-Warranto/mandamus has also been sought to take immediate action restraining respondent No. 7-Satnam Singh, retired Secretary of the Society from entering into the Society and its office premises. Mandamus has also been sought for dissolution of Managing Committee of the Society and conduct fresh elections.

Having considered the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, this Court does not find any ground for issuing mandamus/quo-warranto, as prayed for by the petitioners, as the Forum available to the petitioners is provided under the Statute, which remedy they have not availed of. That apart, as far as the quo-warranto is concerned, no material has been placed on record to substantiate the contentions raised qua respondent No. 7-Satnam Singh.

The writ petition being devoid of merits, therefore, stands dismissed.
