In the instant writ petition, petitioner has challenged the disciplinary proceedings initiated and so also the final order passed in the disciplinary proceedings dated 15.05.2017. Author of Annexure P-6 is office of the Commandant, 135 BN BSF, Ramgarh, Jaisalmer (Rajasthan). As on the date of passing final order dated 15.05.2017, petitioner was serving in Rajasthan. Therefore, cause of action arises in the State of Rajasthan. Consequently, present petition is not maintainable on the ground of territorial jurisdiction.

Accordingly, petition stands dismissed. Reserving liberty to the petitioner to approach appropriate forum.
