The petitioners have filed the instant petition with a prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to provide an opportunity for detailed consultation with Residents' Welfare Associations/Federations of all types by Chandigarh Housing Board while formulating a need based policy.

After hearing the learned counsel for the petitioners, we are of the opinion that no such mandate can be issued in the absence of any requirement. It is entirely upto the respondents to take into consideration the concerns that may come before them through representations and if the petitioners have done so, the respondents may also take into account the suggestions put forward by them.
