The present application has been filed for disposing of the main case i.e. CWP-27930-2017 in view of the compromise dated 26.2.2018, Annexure P-12 arrived at between the parties.

As per the assertion made in the application, during the pendency of the present petition, the dispute has been amicably settled between the parties in terms of the compromise dated 26.2.2018 (Annexure P-12) and the statements of the parties have been recorded before the learned Civil Court, which are annexed with the application as Annexures P-13 and P-14 and the suit titled “Kashmir Singh vs. Surinder Singh”

pending adjudication before learned Additional Civil Judge, Senior Division, SBS Nagar was ordered to be dismissed as withdrawn vide order dated 28.2.2018 (Annexure P-15).

Accordingly, as the *lis* stand settled between the parties, the present application is allowed and CWP-27930-2017 is hereby disposed of in terms of the compromise / agreement between the parties dated 26.2.2018 (Annexure P-12).

However, as neither the parties have caused appearance before this Court nor the composite affidavit has come on record, it is ordered that in case the parties are still left with any grievance, the aggrieved party shall have the liberty to revive the present petition within three months from today.
