The petitioners are seeking direction to the respondents to exempt/relax them from the condition of passing type test on the promotion as per policy dated 09.01.2014 and office order No. 99 dated 05.04.2013.

The petitioners were appointed on the post of Chowkidar on 22.12.1997 and 03.10.2005 (Annexure P-1). Thereafter they were promoted to the post of Bill Distributor on 02.01.2001 and 12.01.2011 and further promoted to the post of LDC on 01.05.2013 and 15.04.2013 vide order dated 15.04.2013 with the condition to pass type test (Annexure P-2).

The case of the petitioners is that vide office order No. 99 dated 05.04.2013, there was no condition to pass type test in the policy.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that some of the employees have challenged order of passing type test in **CWP-5367-2014 Satyanarayan V/s. Uttar Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam Ltd. and others** (Annexure P-3) and **CWP-13658-2013 Chiranji Lal V/s. Uttar Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam Ltd. and others** (Annexure P-4) and a direction was given to the respondents to consider their representation with regard to relaxation from passing type test.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further contends that pursuant to above said judgments (Annexures P-3 and P-4), the Department has granted exemption.

A detailed legal notice seeking same benefit of relaxation has been given by the petitioners on 17.05.2018 (Annexure P-5)

This petition is being disposed of by giving direction to respondent No. 2 to look into the legal notice dated 17.05.2018 and pass appropriate order in accordance with law.
