AJAY KUMAR MITTAL, J.

1. The petitioner who claims himself to be the bonafide purchaser of the secured assets has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for quashing the letter, Annexure P.5, order dated 14.6.2018, Annexure P.4 and possession notice dated 14.3.2018, Annexure P.3. A writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents not to create any third party right qua the property in dispute.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner either to approach the respondent-Bank at the first instance or to take recourse to the alternative remedies as may be available to her in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn.
4. It shall, however, be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to her, in accordance with law.
