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**JASWANT SINGH, J.(ORAL)**

Petitioner possesses the stated qualification of M.A. (History) and B.Ed and after marriage is a resident of Kaler Kalan, District Gurdaspur. By filing the present writ petition she is claiming employment as an Education Volunteer under the Project of Sarv Shiksha Abhiyan in the light of the Policy dated 29.11.2004 (P-1).

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court Mr. Anupam Singla, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of State Project Director, Sarv Shiksha Abhiyan-respondent no.2. He points out that vide revised Policy dated 18.07.2011, a decision was taken not to appoint any Education Volunteer w.e.f. 29.04.2012. He thus submits that the Policy decision P-1 stood revoked. That apart he submits that after the issuance of the notification dated 23.08.2010 issued by National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) the

statutory regulatory body, one of the essential requirement prescribed for teaching Class-I to V is of passing of the Teachers Eligibility Test (TET) conducted by the Punjab Government. The Petitioner thus would otherwise would also not be eligible for appointment.

After hearing counsel for both the parties, keeping in view that the Policy Decision P-1 stood revoked, no case for interference is made out.

Dismissed.
