ARUN PALLI, J. (Oral)

The petitioners are employed as JBT Teachers except petitioner No.18, who is serving as Head Teacher, with the respondent-department. They are aggrieved by their transfers, pursuant to the orders of an even date i.e. 17.09.2016 (Annexures P3 & P4).

Ex facie, the orders of transfer of the petitioners were passed as back as on 17.09.2016, and a period of over 1½ years has gone by. Further, in the absence of any interim order granted by this Court, in compliance to the impugned orders, the petitioners had since joined at their respective place of postings and are serving as such. However, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the impugned orders are in breach of the Teachers Transfer Policy-2016 of School Education Department, Haryana (Annexure P1). And, in certain matters in terms of Clause 5 (vi) of the said policy, the

respondent-department had even cancelled the transfer orders and those employees were sent back to their original place of posting.

In response, learned State counsel submits that claim/grievance of the petitioners shall be considered and dealt with by the respondents in the wake of the Transfer Policy, as referred to above, within a period of three months from today. And appropriate orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed.

The petition is accordingly disposed of in the above terms.
