Learned counsel for respondents No. 2 to 4 contends that in compliance to order dated January 18, 2017, the petitioner has since been disbursed a sum of ₹43,31,845/-, vide cheque No. 358416 dated 23.1.2018. Further, a sum of ₹10,00,000/- has been deposited in the form of Fixed Deposit Receipt to defray expenses on account of future transportation, attendant charges, special diet etc. He has produced a copy of the communication dated 29.1.2018 issued by SDO (Op) S/Divn., UHBVNL, Murthal, which is taken on record as Mark A.

That being so, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that nothing substantive survives in this petition and the same be disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.
