The petitioner approached this Court with a prayer that illegal encroachments from the Panchayat land be removed with further prayer that application filed by the petitioner under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 was not entertained by the authority concerned.

On October 12, 2018, we passed the following order:-

*“Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only
at this stage for 29.10.2018.*

*Mr. Ankur Mittal, Additional Advocate General,
Haryana, present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of
respondent Nos.1 to 4. Copy of the petition be supplied
to learned State counsel during the course of the day.*

*Learned State counsel shall apprise the Court on
the next date as to number of petitions pending with
different Assistant Collectors in the State, filed under*

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*Sections 7 and 13-A of the Punjab Village Common
Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 and also an affidavit of
the Secretary to department concerned in this regard.”*

Affidavit in terms thereof has been filed by in Court by Sudhir Rajpal, IAS, Princilpal Secretary to Government Haryana, Development and Panchayat Department which is taken on record,copy whereof has also been placed on record of CWP No. 20690 of 2018.

Learned counsel for the State submitted that the petitioner may file an application before the Asstt. Collector Ist Grade, Karnal on any day, the same shall be entertained and disposed of in accordance with law.

In view of the aforesaid stand taken by learned counsel for the State, the present petition is disposed of. However, issues as noticed in the order dated 12.10.2018 will now be taken up in CWP No. 20690 of 2018 titled Ishar Singh and others vs. State of Haryana and others.
