The petitioner/Smt. Sarli Devi Shiksha Samiti has filed the instant petition praying for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 i.e. the Director, State Council of Educational Research and Training, Gurgaon to approve the faculty of the college being run by the petitioner/Samiti in terms of a Letter of Intent dated 13.09.2018 issued by the National Council for Teachers Education (Annexure P-3). It is submitted by counsel that such approval at the hands of respondent No.2 is a pre-requisite for permanent recognition to be issued in favour of the petitioner/Samiti by the National Council for Teachers Education for the D.El.Ed. Course.

On the last date of hearing i.e. on 12.10.2018, a copy of the writ petition had been handed over to the learned State counsel for assistance.

Mr. Ravi Partap Singh, learned AAG, Haryana submits that the writ petition may be disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to examine the matter in the light of a representation dated 08.10.2018 (Annexure P-5) that has already been filed.

Counsel for the petitioner/Samiti does not oppose such course of action and rather adverts to an order dated 07.08.2018 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court in **CWP-19204-2018 (Naveen Shiksha Samiuti Versus State of Haryana & another)**, wherein also under similar circumstances, directions had been issued to the Director, State Council of Educational Research and Training, Gurgaon to decide the representation that had been preferred by the concerned Samiti.

In view of the above and without going into the merits of the case, the instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take a final decision on the representation dated 08.10.2018 (Annexure P-5) strictly in accordance with law and as early as possible and in any case, within a period of 10 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
