This petition is filed for seeking a writ in the nature of Mandamus to direct the respondents not to pass/take high tension wire above the building of the petitioner college.

Counsel for respondent no.2 has submitted that electricity line is being taken from Sub Divn. Devigarh to Sub Divn. Rajpura and for that purpose, a notification on 11.08.2011 was issued by the Punjab State Transmission Corporation Ltd. and invited inviting objections as well. The petitioner was not one of the objector because it had purchased the land in question in 2013 i.e much after the issuance of notification.

Learned counsel for the respondent no.2 has further submitted, on instructions from Er. Nirmal Singh, Sr.XEN, TLSC Divn. Mohali, that 90% work of the transmission line is over and rest is pending due to the pendency of this petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has failed to point out any provision of law on basis of which this Court can issue direction to the

respondents for not taking the said electricity line over and above the premises of the petitioner which has been constructed much after the said scheme was formulated.

Thus, in view of the aforesaid, there is hardly any scope in this petition for the purpose of interference.

Dismissed.
