Present writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of directions to the respondents to release the retiral benefits of the petitioner i.e. leave encashment, gratuity, provident funds and other pensionary benefits with interest at the rate of 18% per annum.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner herein retired from service on 31.10.2013 and there was no disciplinary proceedings pending against him. Even by now, there are no disciplinary proceedings against him, but his retiral benefits have not been released to him despite of legal notice dated 06.06.2018 (Annexure-P13) having been issued on behalf of the petitioner.
