During the course of hearing today learned State counsel upon instructions from Ms. Reetu, Legal Assistant, Education Department, Haryana, makes a statement that provisional recognition would be granted in favour of the 309 member schools of the petitioner-NISA Education within a period of one week from today.

Learned State counsel has further apprised the Court that in pursuance to such provisional recognition that would now be granted in favour of the petitioner-NISA Education, it would be open for them to apply before the Board of School Education Haryana, Bhiwani for purposes of grant of provisional affiliation upon payment of requisite fee as also on completion of other requirements as mandated in accordance with law.

In the light of such categoric stand taken on behalf of the State, counsel representing the petitioner does not press the instant petition and the same is, accordingly, disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
