Present writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to decide the petition for review of the order dated 19.04.2007 passed by C&MD, which was received by the petitioner on 12.03.2018 after almost 12 years and thereafter review petition was filed, which is maintainable before respondent No.2 as the same has been filed within six months of receipt of the order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner has reasonable apprehension that the relevant record would be destroyed by the respondents just to cover their lapse.

In view of above, the present writ petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to look into and decide the review petition pending before him expeditiously and preferably within a period of three months.
