Petitioners are seeking direction to the respondents to grant interests at the rate of 18% per annum to them on the arrears of salary in lieu of stepping up of their pay at par with their juniors as the pay of the petitioners was fixed wrongly at a lower stage due to misinterpretation of Haryana Civil Services (Revised Pay Rules) 2008 and also at parity with those who were on the same footing and were granted the arrears along with 6% interest.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has referred to the letter (Annexure P-5) which has been issued by District Elementary Education Officer, Sirsa to all the Block Elementary Education Officers Rania, Sirsa-II to release the arrears of the petitioners in CWP No.3942 of 2016 titled Rupinder Kumar and others Vs. State of Haryana and others along with 6% interest in three days with a further condition of the decision of SLP/LPA. He has further referred to the judgment passed by this Court in CWP No.11254 of 2010 titled Neelam Rani Vs. The State of Haryana and others whereas, arrears of salary has been given to the petitioner as par with her

petitioners to the respondents/Authorities but no action been taken in this regard.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of by giving directions to the respondents/Authorities to look into the legal notice of the petitioners (Annexure P-8) and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of 6 weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
