Present writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of directions to the respondents to look into and decide the claim having been raised by the petitioner on account of reimbursement of medical bills of the deceased husband of the petitioner, who retired from Education Department as Headmaster (Primary School) and amount of medical bill is Rs.2,48,416/-.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner has already made representation/legal notice on 07.09.2016 and another legal notice dated 06.05.2018 (Annexure-P11) to the respondents thereby raising the same claim on account of payment of medical expenses with interest, but that has not been decided.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Pankaj Mulwani, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Haryana. Complete copy of paper book be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of with direction to the respondents to look into and decide the legal notice dated 06.05.2018 (Annexure-P11) expeditiously and preferably within a period of three months.
