Rajan Gupta, J.

Petitioner has prayed for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus to direct the official respondents to protect his life and liberty at the hands of private respondents. According to him, he is being threatened by private respondents No.8 to 11, who are stopping him from entering in his property.

This court is of the considered view that averments made in the petition cannot be accepted as such. There is no material on record in support of such averments. Even otherwise, it is duty of the State to protect the life and liberty of its citizens. In case private respondents are interfering in his possession, he has remedy to file civil suit for injunction to restrain them from doing so. No direction is, thus, necessary.

Dismissed.
