KRISHNA MURARI, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral):

After the matter was heard at some length, when confronted with the observation that the mandamus prayed for in this petition cannot be granted inasmuch as an order passed by the State Pollution Control Board withdrawing the consent and the order dismissing the appeal challenging the said order has not been challenged in this writ petition and that even if the petitioner is permitted to amend the writ petition and adding the prayer there is a statutory alternative remedy available to her before the National Greens Tribunal, learned counsel for the petitioners finding it difficult to assail the proposition, sought leave of the Court to permit withdrawal of the writ petition.

Prayer made is allowed.

Petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.
