1. In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for a writ of mandamus for consideration of his legal notice in relation to selection and appointment to the post of Fireman.
2. On 05.06.2015, respondents have communicated that petitioner's name has been kept in reserve list in OBC category. Respondents in their statements of objection produced result sheet for the post of Fireman held on 26.06.2013 at 71 OMP wherein petitioner has secured 89 marks and selected OBC candidate one Sh. Kapil Dev Samota has secured 97 marks. Thus, petitioner has not made out a case for selection and appointment to the post of Fireman.
3. Accordingly, petition stands dismissed.
