JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner is serving as a Constable (Bulger) in the C.R.P.F. Since 7.10.2005. He after having served for 6 years in Jammu and Kashmir, was transferred to Delhi in May 2013, on medical grounds. Thereafter, he was transferred to peace station at Group Centre, Sonapat on 12.2.2017, because he belongs to a permanent disabled category.

The grievance of the petitioner is that vide impugned order dated 13.9.2018 (Annexure P2), he has been transferred back to 75 Batallion, Srinagar, in violation of the provisions of standing order No.7 of 2015 (P-3), especially for permanent disable category.

This Court vide order dated 16.10.2018, had issued notice of motion for today.

At the time of resumed hearing today, Mr.Shivoy Dhir, Central Government Counsel, appearing for Union of India – respondents, states that the transfer of the petitioner to 75 Batallion, Srinagar, vide impugned order dated 113.9.2018 (Annexure P2), has since been withdrawn vide order dated 25.10.2018. A copy of order dated 25.10.2018 has been placed on record as **Mark-A**.

In view of above, the instant writ petition is dismissed as having rendered infructuous.
