Petitioner is a 23 years old able bodied man. His brother Gurpal Singh while serving as Chowkidar with the office of PUNSUP at Mansa died on 13.7.2018. Admittedly he is survived by his widow Khushpreet Kaur and a minor daughter Navneet Kaur, and aged mother Baljit Kaur. Widow is stated to be 5th class pass and although eligible for appointment on Class-IV posts, however, is stated to have surrendered her right of consideration for compassionate appointment by filing an affidavit in favour of the petitioner. The petitioner is thus claiming a transferable right of compassionate appointment.

After arguing for sometime, learned Counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
