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KRISHNA MURARI, C.J. (ORAL)

The petitioner has an alternative remedy of approaching the Director, Food Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Punjab under clause 16 of the Policy for Labour and Cartage of Food Grains (Year 2018-2019) and clause 2(d) thereof prescribes the Director to be the competent authority to entertain an appeal.

2. Since the petitioner has the remedy available under the said policy and the dispute involves adjudication into questions of fact, we are not inclined to interfere in the matter and relegate the petitioner to avail the alternative remedy, if so advised.

3. The writ petition accordingly stands dismissed on the ground of existence of alternative remedy.
