Through the instant petition preferred under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash the judgment dated 23.07.2018 (Annexure P-1) passed by respondent No.1, whereby, the OA filed by the respondent-Bank was allowed vide order dated 13.07.2015.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to the petitioner to avail alternative remedy available to him.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to him, in accordance with law.
