Present writ petition is for issuance of directions to the respondents to grant the petitioner full pension which is not being paid on frivolous objections having been raised in letter dated 14.10.2004 (Annexure P1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner is, otherwise, entitled for full pension as he had already put in 22 years of service. However, his claim of full pension has been rejected on the ground that petitioner had availed extraordinary leave, though the same was sanctioned by the competent authority and was for a short duration only. Learned counsel further contended that petitioner has already got issued legal notice dated 04.05.2017 (Annexure P3), but the same has not been decided so far.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mrs. Anju Arora, Additional Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. A complete copy of paper-book be provided to her during the course of the day.

In view of above, present writ petition stands disposed of with the directions to respondent No.2 to look into and decide legal notice dated 04.05.2017 (Annexure P3) expeditiously and preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
