Reply by way of affidavit of Superintendent, District Jail, Kaithal on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 4 filed in Court today is taken on Court.

Heard.

Petitioner seeks parole under Section 3(1) (a) of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release Act), 1988 for four weeks on medical ground as the wife of the petitioner is admitted in the hospital since 3.10.2018.

As per the reply filed, State has taken an objection that as per Section 4 (1) of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release Act), 2007, application for parole has to be submitted to the concerned authority which is Superintendent of Jail. No such application has been filed before the Superintendent of Jail, Kaithal.

It being so, present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to move an application before the Superintendent, District Jail, Kaithal, Haryana.

If such an application is filed, the Superintendent, District Jail, Kaithal will take necessary action in the matter within three days and the Commissioner of Police, Kaithal shall decide the same within 30 days from the date of receipt of the recommendation from the Superintendent, District Jail, Kaithal.

Disposed of with aforesaid direction.
