It is not in dispute that the petitioners had made a representation Annexure P-4 dated 10.9.2018 in the matter of deletion of the voters name from the list of voters. It is also not in dispute that the Deputy Commissioner, District Roopnagar did not decide the same.

The Authority i.e the Deputy Commissioner, Roopnagar was under obligation to decide the representation upon hearing the parties, if necessary, and also upon perusal of the relevant records.

In our opinion, the issue being small, the Authority should

decide the representation Annexure P-4 dated 10.9.2018 in one way or the other, in accordance with law and if necessary after hearing the petitioners or their representative, within a period of two weeks from today.

Copy of this order shall be placed before the concerned Authority by the petitioners.

The petition stands disposed of with direction as aforesaid.
