Petitioning Association has no apparent *locus standi* to espouse individual institutional grievances of private educational colleges and bring them to writ court in a single petition to ignite its extraordinary and discretionary jurisdiction. The Association has filed the instant petition through the “National President” without naming him in the memorandum of parties/cause title, which is a grave defect in establishing identity and is sufficient for this court not to proceed to summon the respondents. The individual College/s is/are free to approach a court of law for ventilating their grievance/s in case they feel aggrieved, as of them who may be members of the Association.
