By virtue of the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ, order or direction to the respondents for revision of ACP to the petitioner from the date of first entry in the respondent department and after regular service since 1981 and further granting seniority for the post of ALM with the respondent department as his appointment to the post of SA was taken as quite afresh and he was not granted any seniority for his earlier post of ALM along with all other consequential benefits.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that various representations including Legal Notice dated April 10, 2017 (P-1) were made to the respondents but till date neither any reply to the said representations/legal Notice has been received nor any final order has been passed by the respondents.

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3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that she feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to decide the Legal Notice dated April 10, 2017 (P-1) in a time bound manner.

4. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his Legal Notice dated April 10, 2017 (P-1) and take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order considering all the facts narrated in the aforesaid Legal Notice, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

5. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved against any of the order(s) passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
