In the instant writ petition, petitioner has sought for the following relief:-

“(i) Issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondent to send the petitioner for training as per passing of the written test, physical ability test, being figure out in the list of recruitment of candidate, so as the sending the petitioner for training is kept lingering on with further awaiting the place of recruitment of the petitioner.

ii) Issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondent to send the petitioner in the upcoming batch for training and allocate the place of recruitment may without delay in a time bound manner.”

During pendency of this petition, petitioner was selected and appointed to the post of Constable (G.D.) vide Annexure R-1 dated 17.01.2017. In view of the latter development, petition do not survive for consideration.

Accordingly, petition stands disposed of.

Reserving liberty to the petitioner to approach competent authority for consequential benefits. If petitioner submits representation in that event competent authority is directed to consider petitioner's grievance in accordance with law.
