ARUN PALLI, J. (Oral)

Petitioner claims appointment on compassionate grounds. His father late Gulzar Singh was employed as Assistant Lineman (ALM) at Power Grid Dirba, Punjab State Power Corporation Ltd. Who had died in harness on 01.07.1999. The deceased was succeeded by his widow, four daughters and a son i.e. the petitioner. The petitioner purports to have repeatedly represented to the respondents to consider his claim for appointment in terms of the policy decisions of the Government. But to no avail. And even the notice dated 25.09.2017 (Annexure P2), the respondents have been served with, has failed to evoke any response.

That being so, the petition is disposed of, at this stage, only with a direction to the respondents to consider and decide the claim of the petitioner, as also the legal notice dated 25.09.2017 (Annexure P2), within a period of 3 months from the receipt of certified copy of this order. And pass appropriate orders in accordance with law. Needless to assert that in the

event the claim of the petitioner is declined, the respondent authority shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof.
