The petitioner has invoked jurisdiction of this Court referring to Section 24(2) of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 (hereinafter called 'Act of 2013') claiming that the acquisition in question has lapsed.

A notification under Section 4 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (hereinafter called 'the Act') was issued on 16.11.1981. It was followed by notification under Section 6 of the Act. Award was announced by the Land Acquisition Collector on 28.02.1984. It is not in dispute that the petitioner had received amount of compensation and further it is not in dispute that he is not in possession of the land now.

Keeping in view the aforesaid, there is no case made out for invoking provisions of Section 24(2) of the Act of 2013.

The writ petition is dismissed.
