By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to implement order dated 25.09.2001 (P-1) passed by the Disciplinary Authority which was confirmed vide order dated 19.04.2002 (P-2) by the Appellate Authority and to grant him retiral benefits along-with all other consequential benefits that too, along-with interest @18% per annum.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that though a legal notice dated 10.07.2017 (P-3) was served upon the respondents but despite the fact that a period of more than six months has elapsed, neither any reply has been received by the petitioner nor any conscious decision has been taken by the respondents. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to decide the legal notice dated 10.07.2017 (P-3), within some stipulated period.

3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 10.07.2017 (P-3) in accordance with law, rules and regulations, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, in case the petitioner feels dissatisfied by any inaction of the authorities concerned, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to the other remedies available under law, including to approach this Court.
