The present writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of direction to the respondents to count the daily wage service of the petitioner rendered before regularization as qualifying service for the purposes of pensionary/retiral benefits and also grant pensionary benefits as per the old general provident fund scheme.

Learned counsel for the State, as per the reply, submits that the case of the petitioner is squarely covered by the ratio of law laid down in **CWP No.24472 of 2015** titled as “**Constable Rajesh Kumar and others vs. State of Punjab and another**”, decided on 7.1.2016 (Annexure P-4).

In view of the admission made by the State counsel, respondent No. 2 is directed to pass the consequential order in the matter within six weeks from today.
