Petitioners are seeking directions to the respondents to fix their pay in view of the 7<sup>th</sup> Pay Commission which had taken effect from 01.01.2016. The pay of the petitioners was required to be fixed as per Rule 7 of the Haryana Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 2016 and Rule of 18 of Haryana Civil Services (ACP) Rules, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are working in the Animal Husbandry Department as VLDA (Veterinary Livestock Development Assistants) w.e.f. 1980 to 1990. With the process of time, the petitioners were given the benefit of 3<sup>rd</sup> ACP before implementation of 7<sup>th</sup> Pay Commission, the same was given @ Rs.4200/-. The Grade Pay as well as the 3<sup>rd</sup> ACP of the petitioners was revised @ Rs.5400/- while implementing the 7<sup>th</sup> Pay Commission but while calculating the pay of the petitioners, the same was calculated by taking the grade pay of the petitioners @ Rs.4200/- which was the old one. He has referred to the judgment passed in the case of Kadam Singh Vs. State of Haryana and others passed in CWP No.24673 of 2018 whereby, a direction has been issued for grant of ACP scales. In the present case, petitioners are seeking the same benefit w.e.f. 01.01.2016 as has been required in the aforesaid case. A detailed representations i.e. Annexures P-11 and P-12 have been made by the petitioners before the Director General, Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Panchkula, but no action has been taken in this regard.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, present writ

petition is disposed of by giving directions to the respondents/authorities to look into the representations (Annexures P-11 and P-12) and decide the same within a period of 6 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
