(1) Learned State counsel has handed over a copy of the letter dated 25.09.2018 from the Directorate of Town & Country Planning, Haryana, according to which, if the petitioner has applied for grant of CLU permission for the same purpose on the same land as in his earlier application dated 17.04.2012 in O/o Municipal Council, Kaithal/DULB, then the concerned Department/Authority will not insist the petitioner for deposit of scrutiny fee to the extent it has been already deposited with the Department. This satisfies the petitioner's claim and renders the writ petition as infructuous.

(2) The Municipal Council, Kaithal is accordingly directed to proceed with the petitioner's file in terms of the above-quoted Government letter.

(3) Disposed of accordingly.
