On completion of pleadings, issues were framed on 17.12.2014. Ultimately issues No.1 to 4 were treated to be preliminary issues. This Court vide order dated 25.04.2016 held that the petition cannot be decided on the basis of preliminary issues and the petitioner is entitled to prove the allegations by leading his evidence. Thereafter, the case remained pending on review application, which was dismissed on 03.04.2018 for want of payment of costs. The case was adjourned for today. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner despite number of calls.

It appears that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing this petition any more.

Dismissed in default.
